Clerk: Micki Harnois asked if the Town Council as interested in purchasing a 20' x 40' tent to have in the park for outdoor community meetings. She was asked to check on when it would be delivered. If it isn't until this fall it may not be worth it.

Water: The Council will be voting on the contractor when it is time to accept bids on the water extension project. The water meters will be read on May 30th. Bids for the water line extension are due by June 16th. If bids are too high, the town can rebid. If a supply of materials becomes difficult to obtain, the town can ask for a time extension. The state Health department is currently reviewing the wells and will comment soon.

Park: Ernie Brown is mowing, weed eating and spraying weeds.


Fire Department: New members are needed.


